

JESSE FRANKS SR.

Jesse Franks, Sr., 90, of Woodbridge VA, formerly of Kankakee, IL, died peacefully at his home on Monday, December 26, 2011, after a very brief illness from renal failure. Visitation will be Friday, January 6, 2012 from 5:00 until 8:00 P.M. at Lax Mortuary. Funeral Services will be Saturday, January 7, 2012 at 10:30 A.M. at Caldwell Chapel AME Zion Church, 805 N. Evergreen, Kankakee, IL. Pastor Lori Holmes will officiate and Elder Jesse Franks Jr. will deliver the eulogy. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens of Memory.

Jesse Franks was born in Parkins, Arkansas on December 25, 1921 to Andy and Dora Franks. He was a life-long resident of Kankakee, IL; only moving to Virginia to live with his daughter and son while successfully battling prostate cancer.
