Albert Love, 81, of Kankakee, IL, died Saturday, June 14, 2014 at his home. Visitation will be Thursday, June 19, 2014 from 4:00 P.M. until 7:00 P.M. at Lax Mortuary and again on Friday, June 20, 2014 from 10:00 A.M. until time of Funeral Services at 11:00 A.M. at Shiloh Full Gospel Baptist Church.
