Fredrick G. Miller, 75, of Kankakee, IL, passed away, Friday, August 17, 2018 at Miller Rehabilitation. Visitation will be Friday, August 24, 2018 from 9:00 A.M. until time of funeral services at 11:00 A.M. at Shiloh Full Gospel Baptist Church. Pastor Anthony Reed will officiate. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens of Memory.

Fredrick G. Miller was born March 2, 1943 in Chattanooga, TN to Henry and Clyde Holmes Miller. He graduated from Howard High School in 1961. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Music from Knoxville College in 1977 and his Master's Degree from The University of Tennessee at Knoxville in 1979.
