Mary E. Snapp, age 91, passed away Saturday, May 21, 2016 at her home in Manteno, IL. Visitation will be Wednesday, June 1, 2016 from 10:00 A.M. until time of funeral services at 11:00 A.M. at The Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witnesses, 720 Rowell Ave., Joliet, IL. Burial will be in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery, Elwood, IL.
