Mose Sextion Sr. was born August 31, 1938 in Tensas Parish, Louisiana to Gus and Rosetta Jordan Sextion.

He graduated from Tensas Rosenwald High School in St. Joseph, Louisiana. After high school, he worked as a longshoreman in the Gulf of Mexico and New Orleans Docks. He moved to Pembroke, IL in 1962, after the longshoremen went on strike.

He worked at Agar Packaging in Momence, IL, A & P Supermarket, and Allied Tubing, from which he retired.

He confessed his hope in Christ at Christian Hope Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev Calhoun. Later, he became a member of Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. Alex Bond, where he was a faithful member until becoming ill.

Mose was active in Civil Rights and was a member of the NAACP. He enjoyed working on his cars.

He leaves to cherish his memory, one son and daughter-in-law, Mose and Bonnie Sextion Jr. of Kankakee, IL; two daughters, Debra Sextion of Dallas, TX and Marilyn Sextion of Kankakee, IL; two brothers and one sister-in-law,
