Reno Dillard, 69, of Kankakee, IL, died Friday, February 20, 2015 at Riverside Medical Center. Visitation will be Friday, February 27, 2015 from 10:00 A. M. until time of Funeral Services at 11:00 A. M. at Lax Mortuary. Burial will be in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery, Elwood, IL.
